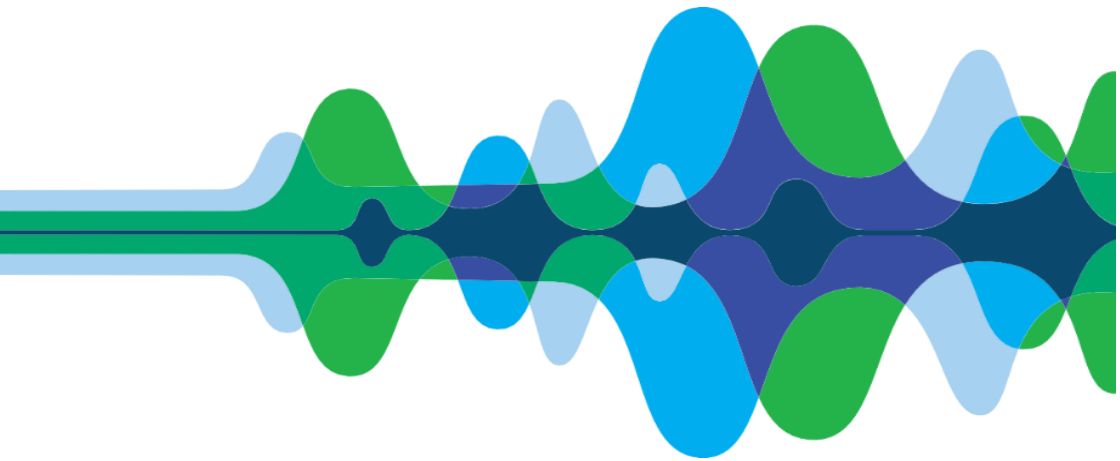





CamJam 2023-2024





CamJam is our Junior Saturday Centre. The following groups and lessons take place at Brecknock Primary School, NW1 9AL on Saturday mornings. They meet in term-time only. There are 10 sessions every term.

Financial help is available if your child is eligible for free school meals.

Mini Jam | 18 months to 5 years

Details: In these exciting sessions, children will develop their skills through movement, listening, singing and exploring music. They will play percussion instruments, compose new songs, work together to play musical games and begin to understand the elements that make up music.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: Foundation

Foundation | Year 1 | Session 1 10.30 – 11.15 | Session 2 11.30 – 12.15

Details: In Foundation, children continue to develop their music skills. They will further develop their singing, movement to music and listening skills. They will also learn to read and write their own music using musical notation and play tuned and untuned percussion instruments. There are two Foundation sessions each morning. Children usually attend both of these.

Cost: £62.36 per term (if attending one session per week), £124.72 per term (if attending two sessions per week).

Next steps: Singing Stars, Music Tech, Junior Soundsmiths, Cello Chickens, Recorder Rockstars, one to one instrumental lessons.



Singing Stars | Year 2 | 10.30 – 11.15am

Details: Our fantastic new singing group for Year 2 students! There will be singing games, new songs and termly chances to perform.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: One to one singing lessons, CamJam Voices

Cello Chickens | Year 2 – 3 | 9.45 – 10.30am

Details: This is our beginner cello group. Children will learn to read music, improvise and play together as a group. There is a concert at the end of every term.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: CamBand, Superstrings, one to one cello lessons

Junior Cello | Year 4 – 5 | 9 – 9.45am

Details: For students who have been learning the cello for at least one term and are in Years 4 or 5.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: CamBand, Superstrings, one to one cello lessons

Recorder Rockstars | Year 2 – 4 | 11.30 – 12.15pm

Details: An opportunity to learn the recorder as part of a small group. There is a concert at the end of each term.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: CamBand, Supertoot, Camden Youth Recorder Group, one to one lessons



Rock Band | Year 3 – 5 | 9 – 9.45am

Details: For students who already learn the guitar, bass guitar, keyboard or drumkit. Rock Band also needs a keen singer! Places in this group are limited so please speak to us if your child would like to join.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: Holiday Course groups, Senior Rock Band

CamBand | Year 2 – 5 | 10.30 – 11.15am

Details: Our CamJam orchestra! For students who already learn an instrument and want to share their love of music by playing with others. Woodwind, string and brass players who have been playing for at least 2 terms are welcome.

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: Training Orchestra, Holiday Course groups

Camjam Voices | Year 3 – 5 | 11.30 – 12.15am

Details: This is our youngest choir, with singers in Years 3 to 5. Anyone can join us!

Cost: £62.36 per term

Next steps: Camden Youth Choir, Camden Young Singers, Camden Senior Singers



Junior Soundsmiths | Year 2 – 5 | 11.30 – 12.15pm

Details: An exciting new opportunity for our young musicians to explore their own and other instruments, electronic and found sounds while working together to compose new music.

Music Technology | Year 2 – 5 | 10.30 – 11.15am

Details: Learn to create and compose music using computer software including Garage Band and Logic Pro. Previous projects include composing Blues music and creating music to accompany an animation.

Next steps: Music Tech and Soundsmiths at Senior Centre


